

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
## 2024 TREASURER'S REPORT

2024 Year End Update - January 1 to December 31, 2024

The VSHA Board would like to thank the **239 out of 450** neighbors who paid their voluntary membership dues last year, in addition to everyone who contributed to the Landscaping Fundraising Campaign since 2022 (see sidebar for update).

#### 2024 DUES...



As you all know, everything has gotten more expensive these past few years and our voluntary dues do not go as far as they used to! For 2025, we have increased the dues for the first time in over a decade. We are now asking \$200 per year (a \$50 increase per home) to cover the routine expenses and also to fund future improvements.

Our main annual expenses are landscaping and general maintenance for the entrance area, irrigation, lighting and the newspaper area, plus fertilization and pest control for all the medians down Venetian Boulevard. Our next biggest expense is the annual service on the front entrance security camera system, followed by the required board insurance, electric and water service, accounting and administration.

#### LANDSCAPING UPDATE

We would first like to send a big THANK YOU to those of you who support your volunteer Homeowners' Association by paying the annual dues and donating to the Landscaping Fund. As someone who has worked since 1997 to beautify the boulevard, I personally believe if all 450 homeowners paid their dues every year, the entire boulevard would already be transformed. But as you can see from the 2024 Treasurer's Report, only 239 homeowners joined last year, so we have a tight budget and the fixed expenses are always going up.

But thanks to the efforts of Landscaping Fundraising Committee members Donna Proskine, Debbie Andreas and Karen Svenson plus the additional donations made along with the dues for the past two years, we were able to:

- Fund a full renovation of the second island behind the entrance sign
- Replace dead plants and mulch in the first "tongue" island
- Repair the broken landscape lighting and broken sprinklers
- Repair the newspaper box pavers next to newspaper boxes
- Provide pest/fertilizing to all median islands and monthly maintenance

We are also working to eliminate the seasonally strong "low tide" smell along the front of the boulevard when entering the neighborhood by installing aerators in the short, closed canals along the boulevard, similar to the ones in the canals on Gulfside, San Marco, Venetian Way and most recently next to Porto Salvo. For that aerator, we owe a big THANK YOU to Consolidated Electrical Distributors for the use of their outlet at no charge. We should also thank our neighbors Paul Carr and Max Makowsky for their work installing and maintaining the aerators.
